

PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

Carter County has received a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development HOME grant from the Tennessee Housing Development Agency (THDA) to rehabilitate homes. This work will be completed by area contractors and will be at minimal cost to QUALIFYING homeowners.

A public meeting has been scheduled to discuss this program with interested citizens. Work to be completed will be substantial, and include roofing, foundations, siding, windows, doors, flooring, etc.

All of the following criteria must be met to qualify:

1. Meet low-to-moderate income guidelines.
2. Have proof that you own your home and the land on which it is located.
3. Reside permanently within Carter County.

If you meet these criteria and are interested in obtaining more information about the grant, please come to a public information session. For the residents of **Carter County** it will be held on **Tuesday, January 29th at 10:00 a.m.** at the Carter County Courthouse, Second Floor Courtroom, 801 E. Elk Avenue, Elizabethton, Tennessee.

This program has a limited amount of funds and not everyone who qualifies will be served. Applications for assistance and other information will be provided at this meeting.
